## Lesson 40

\#19. The teacher incorrectly states that 28 divided by 1.4 is 10 . She goes on to correct the problem in writing but not verbally.

## Lesson 42

Example 3. In steps 2 and 3, the number in the denominator should be $1 \times 10^{-19}$, not $1 \times$ $10^{-18}$. The final answer is correct.

## Lesson 63

Example 1. The final answer should be -16R - 13.2U, not 16R - 13.2U. The teacher leaves off the negative sign but correctly interprets the direction as west.
